## Teen Art Show – Guidelines

---



### Art Guidelines

- Each teen participant (grade 6 – 12) may enter up to **two** original works on paper, no larger than 16” by 20”, in any medium, e.g. sketching (pencil, watercolor, charcoal), painting (acrylic, oil pastel, etc.), sculpture, photography, as well as original works of writing such as poetry and short stories.
- Submissions will be returned after exhibition.
- A registration and photo release form must be submitted along with artwork.

### Writing Guidelines

- Each teen participant (grade 6 – 12) may enter one short story, poem or non-fiction essay.
- Entries must be the original work of the submitter.
- Entries must be typed, on one-sided 8 ½” x 11” paper. Hand written entries will not be considered. Instead of submitting a hard copy, teens can also e-mail a copy of their work as an attachment to: [tanzikristine@mcplibrary.org](mailto:tanzikristine@mcplibrary.org) or [hempedeborah@mcplibrary.org](mailto:hempedeborah@mcplibrary.org) with the subject heading “art show.”
- Pages must be numbered.
- Maximum Pages:
  - Poetry – 2 pgs.
  - Prose (i.e. short story, non-fiction essay) – 4 pgs.

### You may hand deliver artwork and writing submissions to the Lobby Supervisor desk at MCPL Selden – 575 Middle Country Rd., Selden, NY, 11784.

- **All submissions are due between February 8<sup>nd</sup> – February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019**
- Artists may deliver their work during the following times:  
**9:30am – 9:00pm Monday-Friday; 9:30am-5:00pm Saturday; or 1:00-5:00pm Sunday between February 8<sup>nd</sup> – February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the Selden building – Lobby Supervisor desk.**
- Artists may pick up their work for removal during the following times:  
**9:30am – 9:00pm from April 11<sup>th</sup> – April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the Selden building – Lobby Supervisor desk.**
- Work for the art exhibit may not be removed before **April 8<sup>th</sup>** unless prior arrangements are made. Please bring photo identification/library card with you when picking up your artwork.
