Friends Support Mujeres Latinas



In addition to purchasing gifts for MCPL, the **Friends** are always on the lookout for ways to support the many programs that serve our community. One of those ways is to pay for the entertainment for the End-of-the-Year Celebration for Mujeres Latinas that will take place on Saturday, December 8th at 12 noon in the Centereach building. This event usually draws between 75-100 people.

In case you are not familiar with this group, it was formed by our library staff to help our Hispanic population connect with the community through the library while also providing an opportunity for them to make new friends. The group meets at Centereach on Saturdays (1/12, 2/9, 3/9) from noon-1:30 pm and on Wednesdays (1/30, 2/27, 3/20) from 6:30 pm-8:00 pm.

Garage Sale Report

As you may recall, the **Friends** tried something new this year regarding the garage sale. Instead of holding a garage sale in the community room in August, with all of the profits going to the **Friends**, we decided to rent spaces in the parking lot to members of the community who sold their own items. In addition to renting spaces, the **Friends** also sold water and snacks. Patrons who rented spaces were responsible for their own set up and clean up which made it easier for the **Friends**.

After having to postpone the sale twice in August, due to inclement weather, the sale was held on September 15th. We realized a profit of just over \$1200, which was \$400 more than we made last year with our traditional garage sale. This seemed to be a "win-win" situation. We had less work to do before, during and after the sale and we made a greater profit. Since the sale is outside, we decided that we need to schedule it for the fall, not in August when it is so hot. 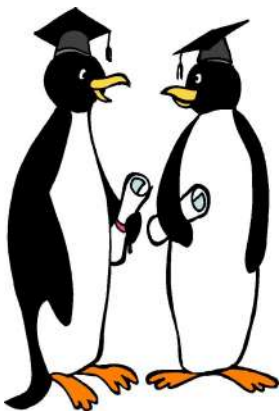
