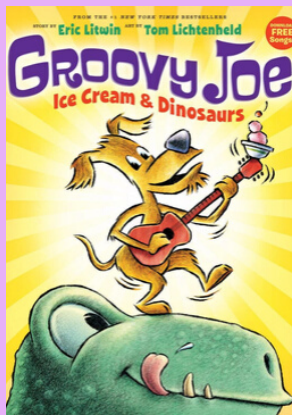

## We Scream for Ice Cream

### Make

#### Kitchen Fun: Ice Cream in Minutes!

#### Ingredients

- 1 Tablespoon Sugar
- 1/2 Cup Milk, Cream or Half & Half
- 1/4 Teaspoon Vanilla Extract (or other flavoring)
- 6 Tablespoons Salt (Kosher or Ice Cream Salt work best)
- Enough ice to fill a gallon-sized bag halfway
- 1 Gallon-sized Ziploc Bag
- 1 Pint-sized Ziploc Bag



#### Directions

1. Fill the gallon-sized bag halfway with ice. Add the salt (ordinary table salt will work, but Kosher salt or ice cream salt, will work much better).
2. Mix the salt around in the ice and set aside. Pour the milk, sugar, and vanilla extract into a bowl or other container and mix.
3. Carefully pour the mixture into the pint bag. Close the bag, making sure it is completely sealed. Make sure the pint bag gets buried in the ice. Seal the gallon bag.

5. Shake the bags vigorously for five minutes. You might want to wear a pair of winter gloves or use a towel to hold them, since they will be very cold and slippery from condensation.
