Download Libby from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.

Answer the prompts: Do you have a library card? Tap **Yes**. Then, tap on **I'll Search for a Library**, and search for **11720**. Then, tap on **Livebrary.com** in the box below.

Next, tap on **Sign in with my Card** & tap on **Middle Country Public Library**. Enter your **library card number** & 4 digit **PIN**. Your digital library card will display, so tap on **Next**. You will be asked if you want to read books in Libby or on a Kindle. Tap on **Skip** & you're ready to find books!

At the bottom of your screen you will see *5 icons*. The 1st icon is where you can **search** for books. The 2nd icon is the **digital catalog**. The 3rd icon will bring you to your Libby **settings**. To see your **account**, tap on the 4th icon at the bottom of your screen. This is where you can view & manage your **Loans & Holds**.

To **search** for books, tap on the 1st icon—the magnifying glass—at the bottom of your screen. You can search for titles or authors, and your search history will be saved. Tapping on the 2nd icon will bring you back to the catalog to **browse** books.

To borrow a book, tap on **Borrow** and you will be brought to a new screen. At the **top** of the screen, tap where it says **14 days**, & select **21** days. Next, tap the burgundy **Borrow** button below the cover image.

To read the book immediately*, tap on **Open Book**. The book will download automatically so that you do not need internet for reading.

**To read the book on a Kindle device, please see the Libby for Kindle instructions*

Unless you select 21 days at your first checkout, the loan period for each title will be 14 days.

Please note that you may borrow up to 7 books at one time, and place 5 holds at one time.
