Cows and pigs live on a farm, on a farm, on a farm.

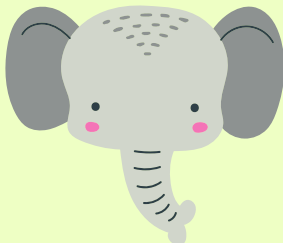

## Craft

### Handprint Tiger Craft:

#### Items Needed:

- Orange Construction Paper
- White Construction Paper
- Black Marker
- Hand to trace
- Scissors
- Tape or Glue



#### 1. Directions:

2. Trace your child's hand on the orange piece of construction paper.
3. Cut out the outline of the hand.
4. Face the cut out hand so the fingers are facing the bottom and draw tiger marks on the cutout hand with the black marker or crayon.
5. Cut a small circle using the orange paper for the tiger face and two smaller circles for the ears.
6. Cut a smaller oval in white paper for the mouth.
7. Glue the small oval onto the larger orange circle.
8. Add the tiger face and mouth. Don't forget more tiger stripes!
9. Add a black dot to each ear and glue an ear to each side of your tiger face
10. Cut a tail out of the orange paper and add some tiger stripes
11. Attach the tail to the back of the tiger.
12. Enjoy your handprint tiger craft!



# Craft

## Handprint Tiger Craft:

### Items Needed:

- **Construction paper**
- **White Paint**
- **Black construction paper or marker**
- **Fork**
- **Glue (Optional)**
- **Scissor (Optional)**



### Directions:

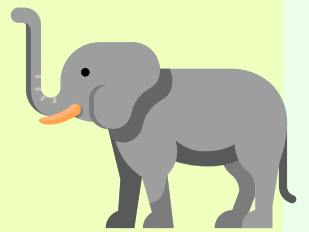
1. Place white paint in a shallow dish. A paper plate works fine for this.
2. Take a fork and dip it into the white paint.
3. Place the fork with paint onto the center of the paper and drag the fork down to the edges. (This will give the line look).
4. Continue this step until you have a circle shape. Let the paint dry.
5. Cut out two eyes, two ears and a nose in black paper and tape or glue them to the dried white paint.
6. If you want to use markers instead of paper for the face, you can draw in the nose, ears and eyes. Just make sure the paint is dry first.
7. You now have the cutest panda craft.
8. Enjoy!!
