Pasta Necklace

Items Needed:

- Assortment of uncooked pasta: macaroni, rigatoni, penne, etc.
- Paint or food coloring
- 1/2 cup vinegar for each cup of water
- 1 jar or bowl filled with 2 cups water for each color
- Cookie sheet or tray
- String
- Scissors
- Paint brush (optional)
- Colander (optional)



Directions:

- 1. Add 1/2 Cup vinegar to the 2 cups of water.
- 2. Add the pasta to the water and vinegar mixture
- 3. Add 4 to 5 drops of paint or food coloring to the mixture
- 4. Soak the pasta in the mixture for at least 20 minutes
- 5. Drain the pasta into a strainer or colander
- 6. Dry the pasta on a cookie sheet for about 30 minutes or until the pasta is dry.
- 7. Use scissors and cut a piece of string to the desired length
- 8. Tie a knot through one piece of pasta.
- 9. Thread the remaining pieces of pasta on the string
- 10. Finally tie the two ends of the string together.

Apple Star Stamping

Items Needed:

- Apples, cut horizontally
- Tempera Paints in different colors
- Paper Plates
- White Construction Paper
- Corn Cob Holder (Optional)



Directions:

- 1. Take an apple and cut it horizontally. You should see a star shape in the middle. (You can place a corn cob holder into the apple for easier control)
- 2. With the cut side of the apple, place the apple in one of the paint colors
- 3. "Stamp" the apple with the paint on to the construction paper
- 4. Try different colors and have fun!
