Create: Homemade Puffy paint





- Food Coloring
- Shaving Cream(1 can)
- White Glue (1 Bottle)
- Stir Sticks (Popsicle Sticks work)

Directions:

- 1. All you need to make your homemade puffy paint is to mix shaving cream and glue. A recommended ratio of 1:1 ratio of shaving cream and glue works best
- 2. If you want to make 4 different colors of your own paint, then split the shaving cream into 4 paper bowls (you can also use a paper plate). Then split up one bottle of liquid white glue between the 4 bowls so that each of the bowls gets a quarter of the bottle.
- 3. Stir until the shaving cream and glue are mixed well.
- 4. If you want some color, then go ahead and add a drop or 2 of food coloring to the bowl and stir until the color is smooth.
- 5. Enjoy!!

White Paper
Different Color Paints
Cardboard Tubes for each paint color
Paper Plate for each paint color
