Description:

In this game, you get to be a pirate. You earn money by completing voyages and collecting treasure. You get to select one of the many pirates you want to be. After selecting your pirate, you can choose to hop on adventure mode, arena, or something called a maiden voyage. The maiden voyage is basically the tutorial of the game. It teaches you the basics of the game, and how to play. Arena mode, is where you get to sail the seas with other players and you have to compete against other players to get the most amount of treasure. Finally, adventure mode is probably the most common mode players use. It is a free roam of the game and you get to select any voyage you want from any faction. Three main factions of getting money you need to know are the Gold Hoarder (treasure chests), The Merchant Alliance (supply runs), and the Order Of Souls (collecting skulls).

Favorite or Least Favorite Part:

My favorite part about this game is that you get to choose what ship you sail in and how many crew members you have on that ship. The three ships in the game are called the Sloop (2 players), Brigantine (3 players), and the Galleon (4 players).
